

TDT Services

Continual Support

Monitor, observe, redirect, and counsel throughout the school day.

Cognitive Behavioral Programming

Help youth discover how their thoughts and choices result in challenges and explore positive alternatives.

Psycho-educational Groups

Focus on skill development in the areas of anger management, problem-solving, coping, social interactions, and effective communication.

Individual & Group Therapy

Crisis Intervention
